

2015 Kids Safe Saturday/Paris Art Fair

KSS Booth Regulations and Stipulations

- Think Child Safety has the right to refuse to allow vendors to exhibit offensive or degrading materials. The use or sale of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, profanity, inappropriate dress, and unprofessional conduct will not be tolerated.
- All KSS Booths will be outside in the parking lot on the North Side of the civic center. Water and Power are NOT available. The use of generators is prohibited due to sound pollution. Vendor spots are 15' wide x 10 deep'. (Exceptions may be made in certain circumstances, we are flexible!)
- Booths of similar products will be limited thus providing vendors less competition the day of the event, subject to the sole discretion of the TCS steering committee, so please register early to secure your spot. There will be no food, craft or KSS booths allowed inside the civic center.
- There is no charge for a KSS booth, but you are expected to keep the area clean after tear down.
- Vendors are responsible for booth set-up and display. Please load and unload as quickly as possible keeping in mind the other vendors. Fire exits and lanes must not be blocked at any time. Think Child Safety volunteers will be available to assist vendor's needs during set up and break down.
- All displays and merchandise MUST remain within the dimensions of the booth space allotted. Contact the Think Child Safety at thinkchildsafety@paristexas.gov for questions concerning logistics. All vendors are responsible for the physical safety of their customers. Be mindful of ropes and cords. (This is a safety event!)
- Vendor stands must remain intact and open until the close of the event. Booths must be broken down by 5pm on the day of the event. Vendors closing before 3pm or vendors who remain at the Love Civic Center after 5pm will be charged a \$50.00 clean up fee.
- Vendors must remove all trash, boxes, and merchandise before check out time of 3pm. All exhibits will be inspected by event staff prior to deposit being returned. Failure to clean the booth will be charged a \$50.00 clean up fee.
- Kids Safe Saturday booths/vendors must provide a service/product to the participants at no charge. There will be no retail selling of any product/service within the KSS booth area.
- Think Child Safety does not provide security and is not liable for damage or loss of personal property. Merchandise left unattended is done so entirely at the owner's risk. However additional patrol by Paris PD will be used Friday night into Sat morning.
- Think Child Safety reserves the right to refuse admission to any vendor(s) or refuse to rent/renew rental of lot(s) at its sole discretion, and reserves the right to amend or change the policies and procedures without prior written notice.
- Vendors may not assign, loan or sublease booth space to another person or entity without specific prior authorization from Think Child Safety.
- Rain or shine, Kids Safe Saturday at the Paris Art Fair will go on. No cancellation or transfers allowed after cancellation deadline of May 1st.
- Tables are available for rent for \$5 each.
- Event is Saturday, May 9, 2015, 9a-3p at the Love Civic Center, 2025 S Collegiate, Paris, TX. Setup is Friday, May 8 from 3p-6p, and Saturday May 9, 7-830a. Tear down 3p-5p.
