



RULES/REGULATIONS FOR PAINTED CHAIR CONTEST

The purpose of the contest is to raise money for the Think Child Safety Program and gain exposure for its many safety programs, exhibits and activities.

1. Entry Form must accompany each chair entered.
2. Chairs must be painted. They may also be decoupaged, beaded, brocaded, bejeweled, rearranged, etc. to embellish/enhance the painting.
3. All chairs must be no more than 2 ft. wide at the widest point, 2 ft. deep (front to back) at the deepest point and 3 ½ ft. tall at the tallest point. No exceptions.
4. All chairs become property of the Think Child Safety Program to be sold at silent auction.
5. Artists may enter more than one chair.
6. Chairs will be accepted between 9:00 and 10:00 AM on the day before the event, May 8, from 4pm-6pm.
7. Judging will commence at 10:00 AM on May 9.
8. All chairs must be safe for use – that is, sturdy, serviceable and capable of being sat on – or they will not be accepted.
9. NO WET PAINT, GLUE etc. or chair will not be accepted.
10. First place wins \$100. Second place \$75. Third Place \$50. Winners will be announced at noon, May 9, and awards given at that time.
11. You do not have to be present to win.
12. Winners' names will be sent to the media after the event.
