Vendor Guidelines

1. All vendors are required to submit a complete and signed application by Wednesday MAY 31, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. to reserve their space. Paris Main Street reserves the right to refuse participation to any applicant.
2. Selling space is approximately 10 x 10.(the size of a parking space) No vendors are allowed to sell items at the Junk in the Trunk away from the designated spaces. Sidewalks must be kept clear.
3. Set up will begin at 7:00 a.m. and will continue through 8:00 a.m. A volunteer will be on each side of the Plaza to guide vendors into designated spaces.
4. For safety reasons the vendors spaces are closed after the sale begins (8:00 a.m.) NO vendor will be allowed to leave until 1: 00 p.m.
5. Trailers are NOT allowed. (a canopy is recommended but not required, but must fit within the selling area)
6. Vendors must furnish their own display equipment and signage, and everything must remain inside the designated space.
7. Vendors must leave space cleaned and completely free from items before leaving after each day. Vendors who are participating for two days cannot leave items on plaza overnight. Tear down will begin at 2:00 and have a one hour limit to finish before traffic control will be re-established.
8. Sale of live animals is not permitted.
9. Trash receptacles on the Plaza are for public use only. Please do not leave unwanted items after the sale in or by the trash receptacles.
10. In the event of overflow of vendors, the Market Square Farmers Market Parking lot will be available.
11. Vendors will be assigned booth by event coordinator and all correspondence will be done via EMAIL. Be sure to check email provided on application for updates and important information.

Paris Main Street is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property. Sale, use or possession of alcoholic beverages or drugs is prohibited on City Property.
