

2015 Kids Safe Saturday/Paris Art Fair

Craft Vendor Regulations and Stipulations

- Think Child Safety has the right to refuse to allow vendors to exhibit offensive or degrading materials. The use or sale of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, profanity, inappropriate dress, and unprofessional conduct will not be tolerated.
- There are both indoor and outdoor booths available this year on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS. There are only 10 booths allowed in the classrooms inside the civic center.
- All Outdoor Craft Vendor Booths will be along the West Side of the civic center, on the grass and sidewalk area. All Indoor Craft Vendor Booths will be inside the civic center in the classrooms on the west side. There are no craft vendor booths inside the Art Fair Area. Water and Power are NOT INCLUDED in the registration fees, and are not available. The use of generators is prohibited due to sound pollution. Craft Vendor spots are 10' wide x 10 deep' outside, and 10' wide x 8 deep' inside. (Exceptions may be made in certain circumstances, we are flexible!)
- Vendors of similar products will be limited thus providing vendors less competition the day of the event, subject to the sole discretion of the TCS steering committee, so please register early to secure your spot. There will be no food or craft concession vendors allowed inside the main civic center area where the Art Fair is.
- Vendors are responsible for booth set-up and display. Please load and unload as quickly as possible keeping in mind the other vendors. Fire exits and lanes must not be blocked at any time. Think Child Safety volunteers will be available to assist vendor's needs during set up and break down.
- Vendors with retail craft products will be considered craft vendors and are limited to outside vendor stands. All decisions whether products are CRAFT or ART will be made by the sole discretion of the Think Child Safety Coordinator and steering committee, no exceptions.
- All displays and merchandise MUST remain within the dimensions of the booth space leased. Contact the Think Child Safety at thinkchildsafety@paristexas.gov for questions concerning logistics. All vendors are responsible for the physical safety of their customers. Be mindful of ropes and electrical cords. (This is a safety event!) Tables are available for rent for \$5 each.
- Vendor stands must remain intact and open until the close of the event. Booths must be broken down by 5pm on the day of the event. Vendors closing before 3pm or vendors who remain at the Love Civic Center after 5pm will be charged a \$50.00 clean up fee.
- Vendors must remove all trash, boxes, and merchandise before check out time of 5pm. All exhibits will be inspected by event staff prior to deposit being returned. Failure to clean the booth will be charged a \$50.00 clean up fee.
- The vendor is solely responsible for his/her merchandise, property and business transactions. Vendors are required to have a Texas sales tax permit, no exceptions.
- Think Child Safety does not provide security and is not liable for damage or loss of personal property. Merchandise left unattended is done so entirely at the owner's risk. However additional patrol by Paris PD will be used Friday night into Sat morning.
- Think Child Safety reserves the right to refuse admission to any vendor(s) or refuse to rent/renew rental of lot(s) at its sole discretion, and reserves the right to amend or change the policies and procedures without prior written notice.
- Vendors may not assign, loan or sublease booth space to another person or entity without specific prior authorization from Think Child Safety.
- Cancellations must be received in writing before the cancellation deadline of April 1 and will incur a \$50.00 cancellation fee. Rain or shine, Kids Safe Saturday at the Paris Art Fair will go on. No cancellation or transfers allowed after cancellation deadline of April 1st.
- Event is Saturday, May 9, 9a-3p at the Love Civic Center, 2025 S Collegiate, Paris, TX 75460. Setup is Friday, May 8 from 3p-6p, and Saturday May 9, 7a-830a. Tear down 3p-5p.
