Lake Crook Hunting Restriction

Article 1, Section 23-29 of the City of Paris ordinances.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or shoot with a firearm other than a shotgun using shot, or with a bow and arrow, on, over, or across any portion of the waters of Lake Crook, or the premises, territory or watershed, owned by the City known as Lake Crook that is not herein designated as an area to be used for hunting purposes.
- (b) All state laws regulating and controlling hunting and all penalties for violations thereof are adopted and made applicable to Lake Crook property, except so far as the same are in conflict with this article.
- (c) The boundaries of the hunting areas districts are established in accordance with the "official Second Amended Lake Crook Hunting District Map", adopted on the 4th day of April, 1996, by Resolution No.96-027. The districts established are restricted as follows:
- (1) Districts 8B and 10 are restricted to no hunting.
- (2) Districts 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8A are restricted to hunting with bows and arrows only.
- (3) District 9 is restricted to hunting for geese or ducks in accordance with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations.
