Racial Profiling – The City of Paris Police Department does not tolerate racial profiling. If you feel that you have been the victim of racial profiling, please carefully read this information and fill out the form for a complaint to be made.

Definition of Racial Profiling: Racial profiling means a law enforcement initiated action based on an individual's race, ethnicity or national origin rather than on the individual's behavior or on information identifying the individual as having engaged in criminal activity. Racial Profiling pertains to persons who are viewed as suspects or potential suspects of criminal behavior. The term is not relevant to witnesses, complainants or other citizen contacts.

Acts of Racial Profiling: Law enforcement *initiated* acts such as a traffic stop, a detention, a search, a citation being issued or an arrest being made based *solely* upon an individual's race, ethnicity, or national origin or on the basis of racial stereotypes, rather than on the individual's behavior or information identifying the individual as having possibly engaged in criminal activity or other lawful reasons for the law enforcement action.

Complaints: Other actions or in-actions by officers or employees of the Paris Police Department which is not considered an act of racial profiling, but you are dissatisfied with our employee's service.
